COVID update

Guidelines for City employees were issued today via a memo to all departments. These guidelines will follow Governor DeWine's June 2 mandates, as well as the CDC suggestions with unvaccinated individuals continuing to wear masks and practice social distancing. As a courtesy to our City Hall visitors, the employees shall be required to wear a mask when meeting without barriers, if the visitor should make that request to the employee. Masks will continue to be made available to City employees for this purpose.

The State's first Vax-a-Million lottery winners were announced last night and the lucky \$1 million winner was Abigail Bugenske of Silverton near Cincinnati. Joseph Costello of Englewood near Dayton was the scholarship winner. Congratulations to both of these individuals and we continue to hope for a Willoughby Hills winner in the future. More than 2.7 million adults signed up for the \$1 million prize and more than 104,000 children ages 12 to 17 entered the drawing for the scholarship. Four more \$1 million and college scholarship winners will be announced each Wednesday for the next four weeks.
