**Fees for Large Item Pick Up:**

Cost included in cart pricing for residents with full service (both carts)

\$12 per item for residents with bag service

**Restrictions:**

Carpet (cut, rolled & tied into lengths not to exceed 4')

Furniture (upholstered furniture must be bagged or wrapped in plastic to prevent bed bug transmission)

Mattresses and box springs (must be bagged or wrapped in plastic to prevent bed bug transmission)

Wood products (bundled and tied in lengths not to exceed 4')

Items should not exceed 50# weight limit.

Refrigerators must have Freon removed

**Other changes to our current contract include:**

Recyclable materials will now include #1 through #5 and #7 plastics, chipboard & corrugated cardboard.

Fuel fees are included in the price per month listed above. The residents nor the City will be billed for fuel fees.

Note: Original prices in the contract were increased on 7/1/19 by \$1.05 to reflect an increase in recycling rates. The above chart reflects these new rates.
